I, Alicia Wardlow, swear and affirm as follows:

1. I am the woman involved in the incident in Duncombe on August 6, 2007. I have read the description of the incident that Curt Ruby prepared. (Exb. WC-S, WC349) It is true and correct to my knowledge and belief, except for the phrase "She has been working with them [DSAOC] as of today." I did not call DSAOC until the next day. Also, I believe that Christopher had been drinking, but I do not think he was on drugs.
2. Over the period of time I was with Christopher Long, deputy sheriffs came to our home very frequently, sometimes twice a week. He was abusive to me, but I loved him very much. He is the father of my two children, who are three years old and twenty months old.
3. On the morning of August 6, 2007 when Sgt. Ruby came to the house, I did not want Christopher Long to be arrested. I didn't know what I wanted to do. I didn't know what Christopher Long would do. I wanted to talk to counselors at DSAOC before I took that step. Sgt. Ruby was respectful of my wishes. My goal was to leave with my small children and get

them to safety, and away from the situation. I wanted time to think and plan and decide what was right for all of us.


4. Curt Ruby gave me the number of DSAOC. He also wrote me a note to give to my employer saying I needed time off to handle this situation. He also specifically gave me permission to leave with my children.

5. I called DSAOC the next day and discussed the situation. They advised me to file charges. I went on August 8, 2007 with the witness, Brandon Ubben, and a person from DHS. Curt Ruby and Luke Fleener drew up and filed the charges.


6. Curt Ruby was real nice to me. He cared about me and my family and our safety. He also recognized that I had a right to decide what was best for my children and myself.

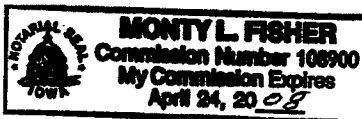
7. Curt Ruby did nothing wrong at all in the way he handled my case. I am grateful for his assistance. I am now no longer with Christopher Long.

Jim,

I separated two subjects in Duncome Monday AM, Alysha Wardlow and Christopher Long. Christopher was reported as having Alysha in the car and he had assaulted her (no details). While I was looking for them he dropped her off at the house and I was flagged down as he took off. Alysha said she was assaulted (no details) but that she had fought back and was worried about what would happen if she pursued the issue. She also wanted to leave with her kids in which she had physical custody at that time, I stated it seemed a good idea. As she was leaving Long showed up and I forbid him to interfere with her leaving as they soon drove away. I had referred her to DSAOC (she has been working with them as of today) as I am aware that he has a history of abusing her (deputies have been to the house a number of times). After she left he was angry and wanted to file charges against a guy that struck him in the face when he was assaulting Alysha, I told him no, and if he wanted he could file a report at a later time after he calmed down and sobered up (actually he seemed more 10-200 than drinking). He called me Mon evening and I told him he could file a report but it could backfire on him based upon the circumstances. We were cut off, I think he hung up on me. Alysha is staying with friends and will probably work on a protective pro se order tomorrow...the reason I am typing this lengthy explanation is because both I and Alysha are concerned he may want to file charges on her or the guy who protected her by going through another deputy, he is not happy about losing control over the situation and she thinks he may try to get his dad to help pressure everyone so that he can get his way. I'm off for the next three so I thought a heads up letter to you might prevent any further non-sense on this guy's part.

Also, there are anhydrous tanks about a 1/2 mile from this guy's place that have been getting hit a lot, and we have people up all hours at his place outside working on cars, etc. plus there is always trouble there.....it may be worth taking note of.
